What You Need to Know

- Film challenge is open to all school aged children and youth residing in Nova Scotia, Canada
 - Films must be **3 minutes or less** in length
- Individuals featured in films must have provided consent for public viewing
 - Films submitted in languages other than English are encouraged but must be **subtitled in English**
- Films must be submitted to Nourish Nova Scotia by **May 30 2023**

Make a Movie - Planning

Plan your story using this year's theme, *Food on the Coast.* Here are some topics to explore with your film relating to food that can be found in or near water:



Family traditions, culture & heritage

Growing, catching or harvesting food

Cooking a favourite recipe



Transporting foods by water



Environment & sustainability



Activism about water and marine life

Make a Movie - Filming

	Choose a location (or multiple locations) to film. Use this checklist to prepare on filming day:
	I will be filming:
	The filming location has good lighting and there is minimal background noise
	The actors are present, have provided consent, and are ready to be filmed
	I have my camera and all other necessary equipment (ex: props, a tripod, etc.)
	If filming outside, I am appropriately prepared for the weather (ex: umbrella, warm coat, etc.)
	Now to film! Here are some tips to help the filming day run smoothly:
A	Find a flat, even surface to place your camera or tripod or ask a friend or family member to hold the camera.
	Be aware of lighting and sounds around you, and remember

Submission Checklist

	Finalize film and save as .MOV or .MP4 file
	If using TikTok to create your film, remember to add the title of your film to the description along with #NourishNS #FoodAndFilm2022 and tag us @nourish_ns.
	Ensure the option "Save to Device" under "More Options" is activated before posting. As long as this option is selected, TikTok will save a copy of your film to your device. To properly submit your film, it must be sent directly to Nourish Nova Scotia using one of the methods listed below.
П	Fill out and submit the <u>online entry form</u>
	Please note that the associated film will become the property of Nourish Nova Scotia and Devour! The Food Film Fest and may be published and promoted publicly.
	Submit the film to Nourish Nova Scotia on or before the deadline of May 30, 2023
	The film can be sent via email (info@nourishns.ca) or shared via Google Drive or WeTranser link. If submitting through Google Drive, please ensure that the option "Anyone with the link can view" is selected.
